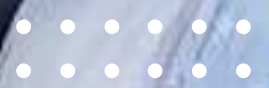

# Family Support Project

- We have provided a whopping 62 million meals in 2022 to individuals and families who lost access to basic food and necessities throughout the war-ravaged country of Ukraine.
- We have collected and shipped 1120 tons of donated humanitarian aid from the USA to Ukraine.





# Refugee Project

- Our refugee center in Lviv provided 1310 displaced families with temporary shelter.







# Child's Smile Project

- Through different children oriented after school programs Hope For Ukraine was able to touch over 4500 children in 10 different regions of Ukraine.



# Medical Support Project

- 23 hospitals received critically needed medical supplies.





# Frontline Project



- Hope For Ukraine volunteers were able to rescue 750 civilians from inside active war zones.
- Every day our volunteers delivered 4-8 tons of food and essential supplies from our warehouse in Lviv to some of the most dangerous places close to the frontline.



# Educational Project



- We have purchased high tech educational equipment for 2 schools that provide education for over 600 kids with special needs.
- In 2022 through ongoing support by Hope For Ukraine these schools were able to enhance their educational process and help these precious children learn complex concepts with ease.





# Christmas Joy Event

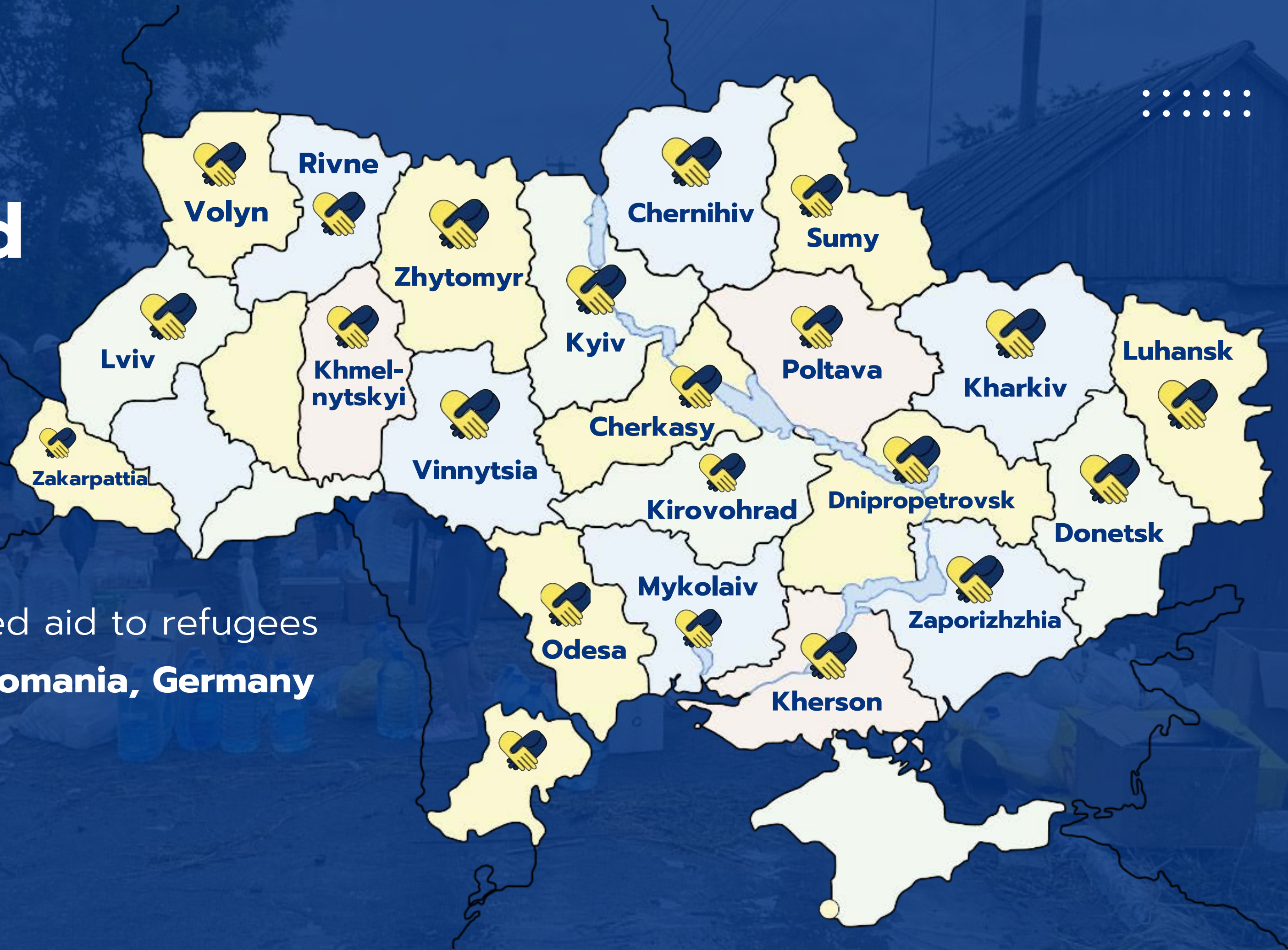
- During holiday season 5600 children all across Ukraine received valuable gifts from Hope For Ukraine.

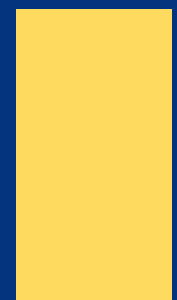

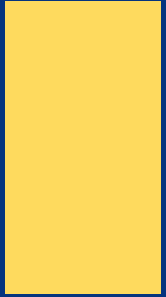

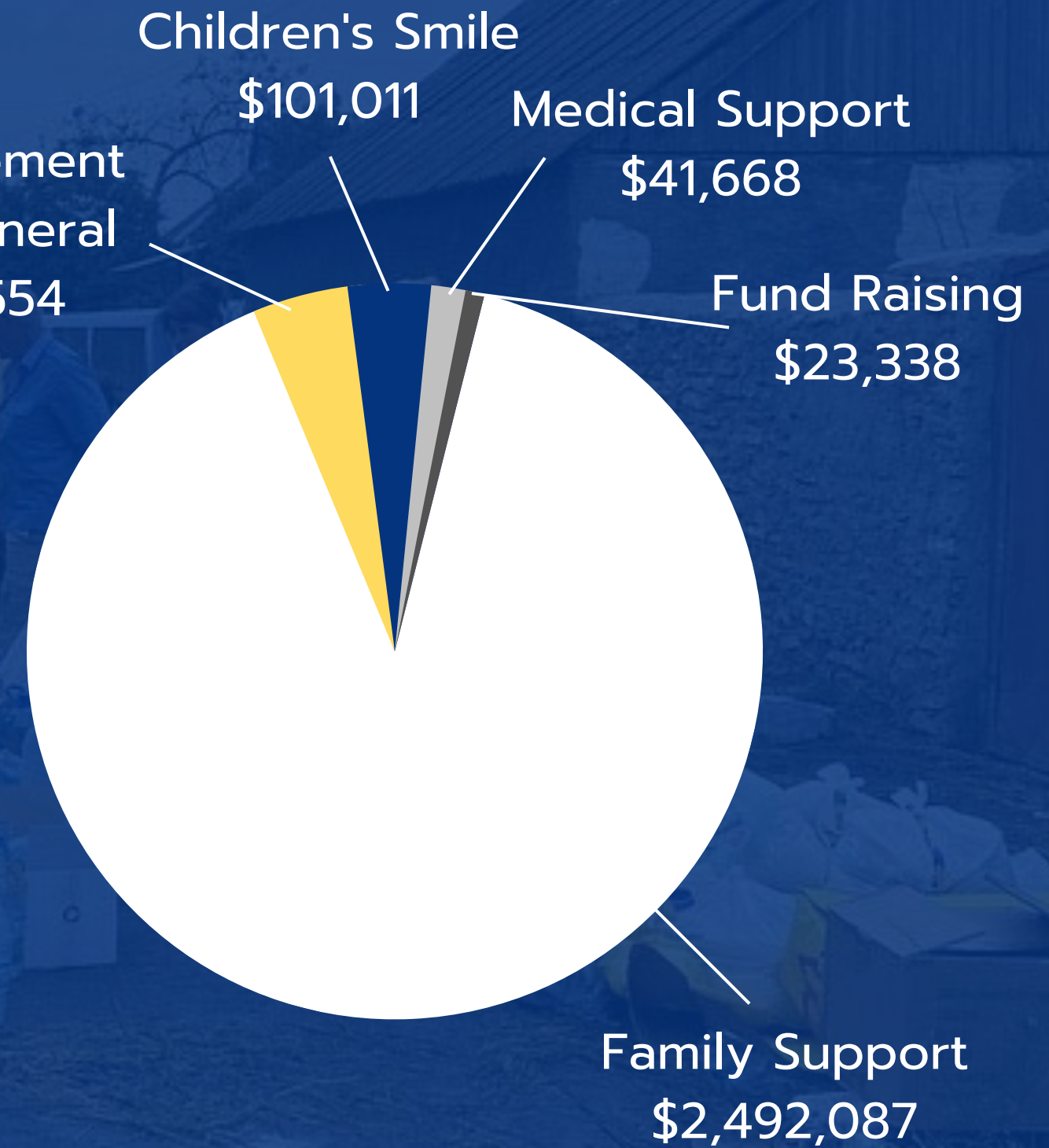
