# Food Kit Distribution

- With remarkable compassion and efficiency, we've distributed 78,000 food kits to those facing severe hardships, each thoughtfully assembled to feed a family of four for up to 10 days.



# After-School Programs

- Hope for Ukraine's after-school programs, attended by 31,200 children, not only enriched education but also created a stable, nurturing community for young minds affected by turmoil to learn, grow, and experience normal childhood moments.





## Rescue Operations

- Our team valiantly conducted operations that rescued 75 people from frontline towns, ensuring their safety from danger. Every rescue highlighted our unified dedication to safeguard and support those in dire circumstances.

# Hospital Support

- We supported 29 hospitals to address urgent medical needs, keeping them operational. This enabled continued healthcare services for those affected by conflict, ensuring access in war-torn areas.







# Refugees Sheltered



- We sheltered 690 refugees, providing solace and support. Our center offers warm beds, nutritious meals, medical care, and help with housing and jobs, aiming to rebuild stable, hopeful futures.



# Aid Delivery

- We delivered 840 tons of aid, showcasing significant logistical skill and commitment. This delivery has been crucial in supplying essential resources to communities affected by conflict, symbolizing our dedication to supporting and rebuilding lives in the hardest-hit areas.





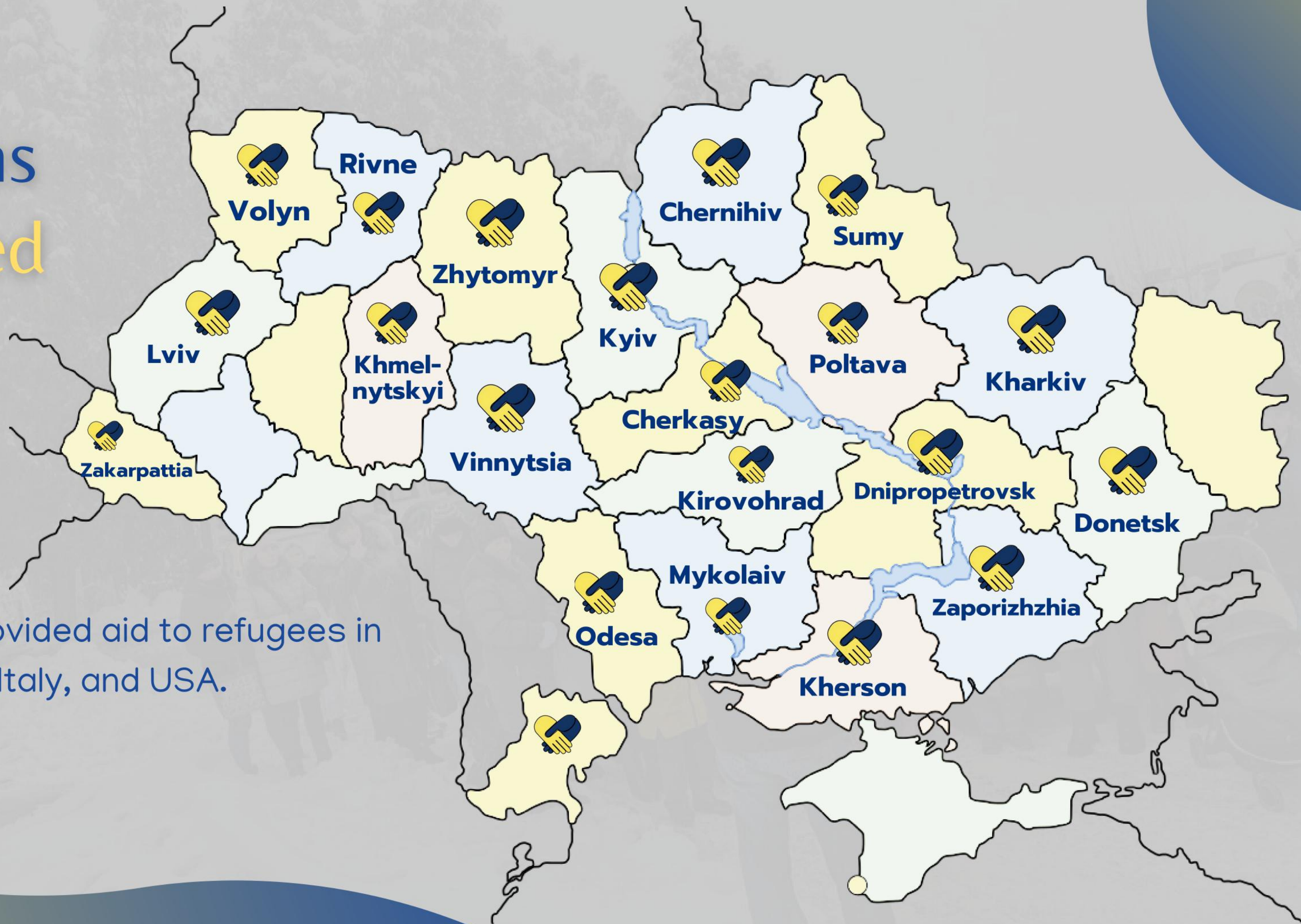
## Christmas Joy 2023

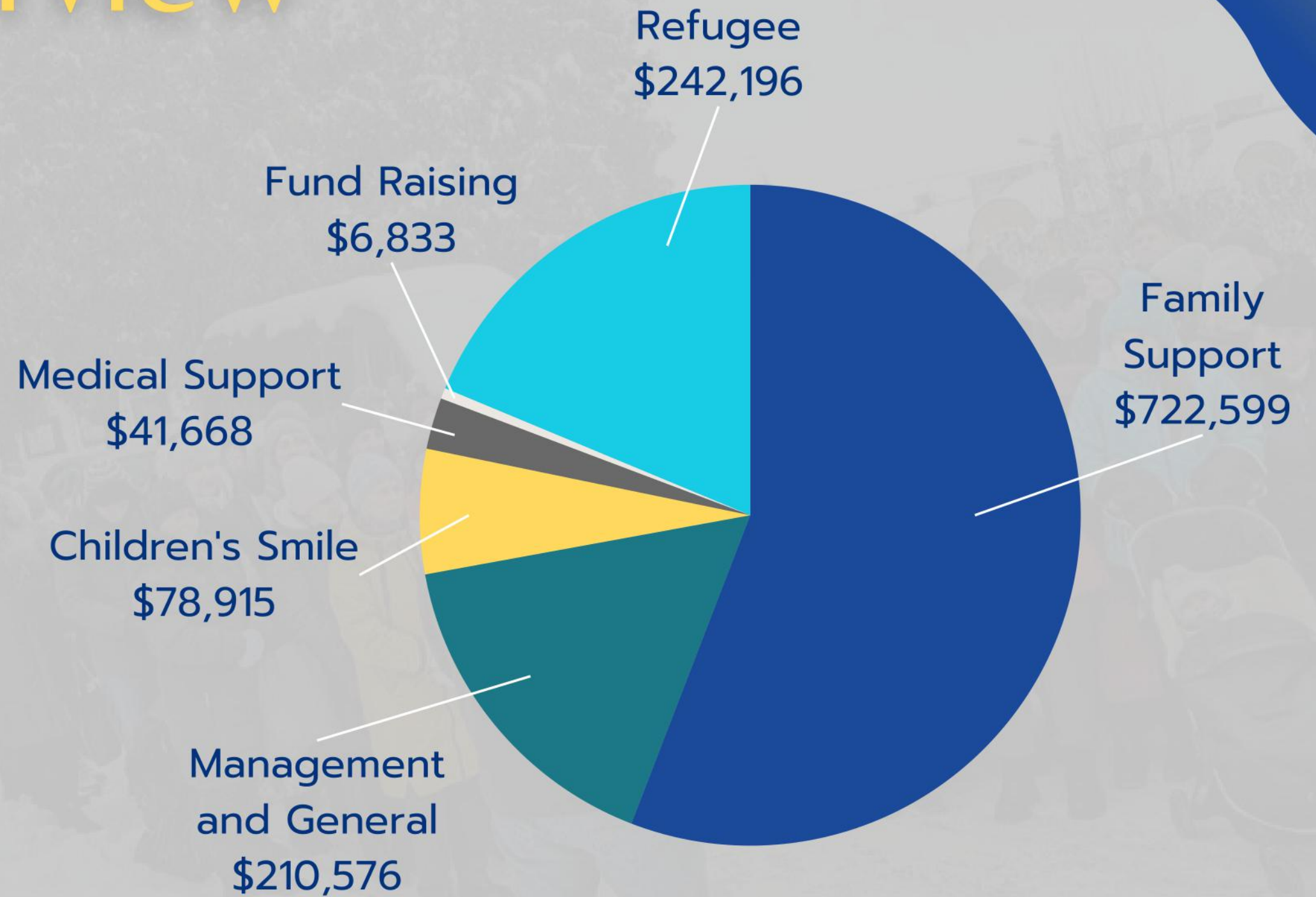

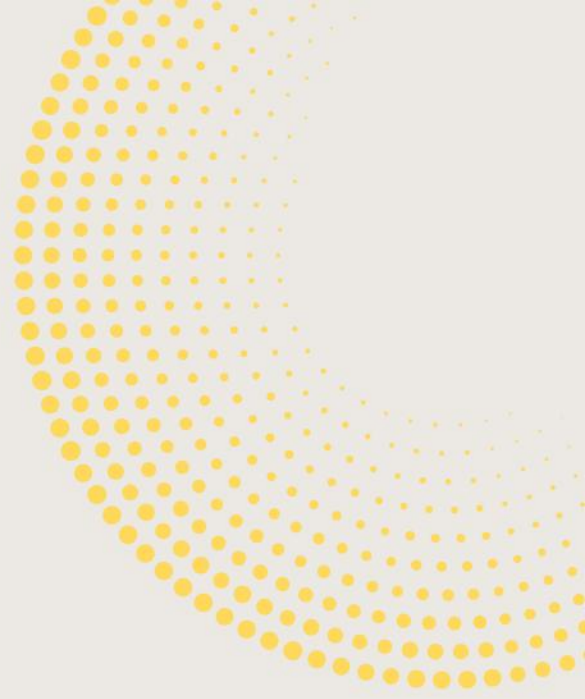
