UKRAINE IN 2025



In 2025, communities across Ukraine continued to face conflict, displacement, power outages, and economic hardship. Despite these challenges, Hope for Ukraine remained present on the ground, delivering critical aid where needs were greatest.





Food Security and Basic Needs

- **88,000 food kits** provided reliable nourishment
- **200 tons of potatoes** supported food stability
- **200 tons of aid** shipped from the US to Ukraine

Energy Resilience

- 1,000 solar energy resilience kits distributed for safe, renewable power for lighting and cooking





Medical and Frontline Support

- **10 stabilization medical containers** delivered
- **10 corrective scoliosis surgeries** funded for children

- **4,000+ children** attended **Summer of Hope Camps**
- **2,000+ Christmas gifts** distributed



Refugee and Displacement Support

- **210 refugee families** in the US supported

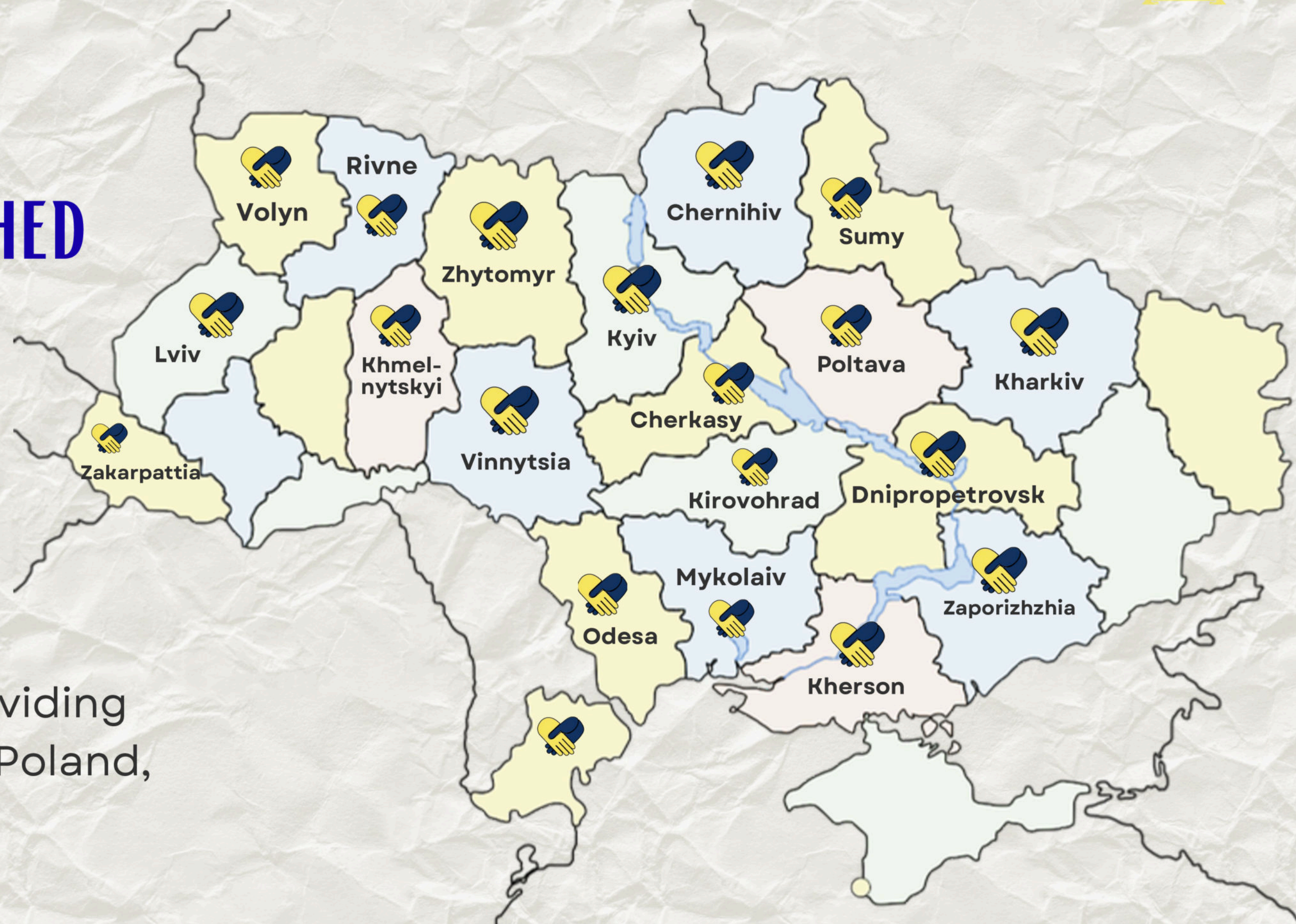

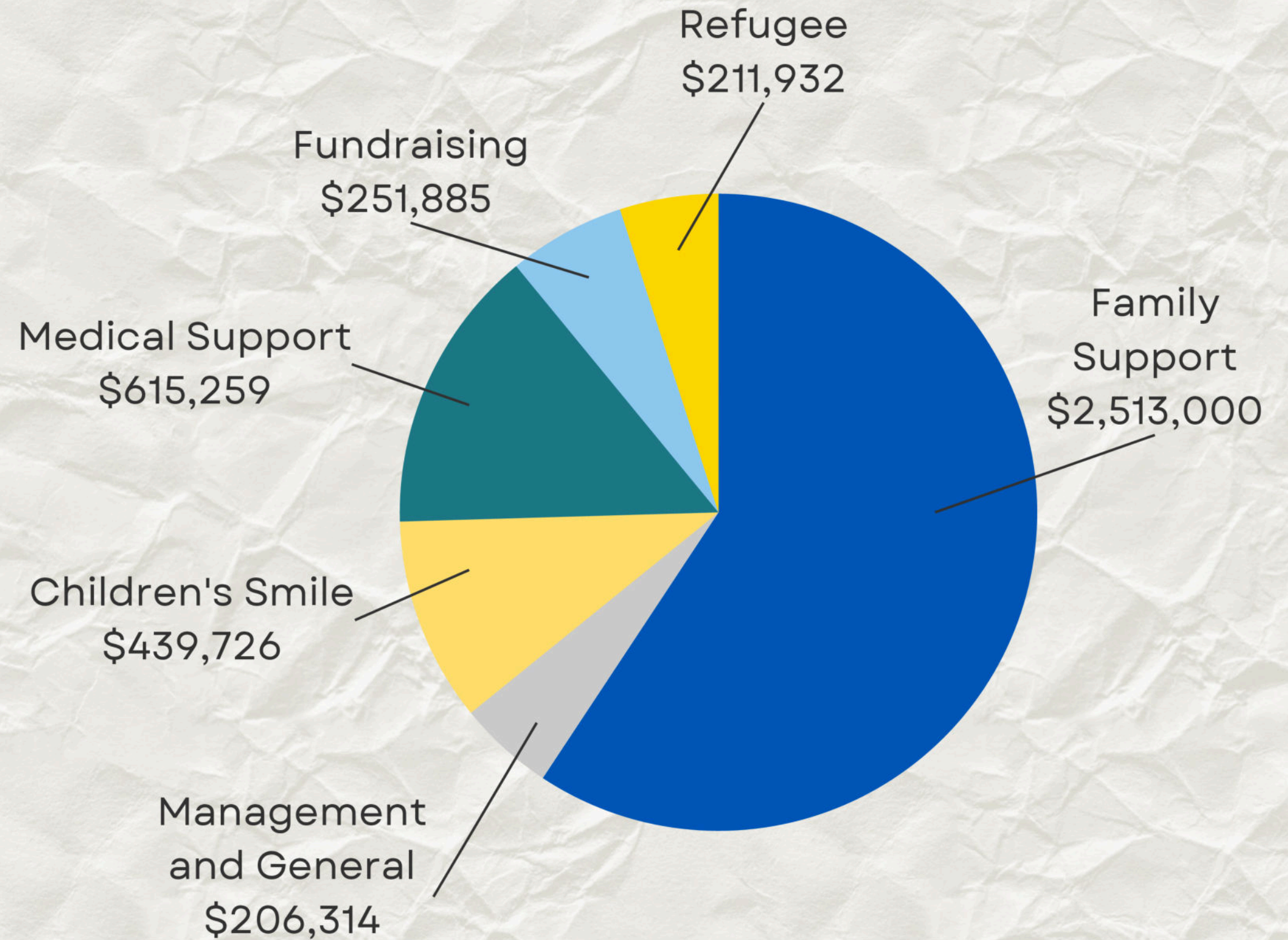
